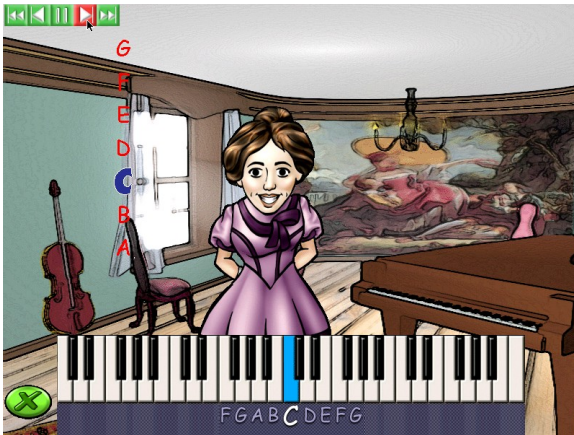




## Lesson 20

Today we learned something special about the Musical Alphabet. We learned that each note on the piano keyboard has an alphabet letter name. The letter names go in order just like the steps on the piano keyboard.

### This Week at Home

- The notes going UP from Middle C go up the alphabet.
- The notes going DOWN from Middle C go DOWN the alphabet.
- Every note has a name. These names will always be the same they never change.
- Miss Melody will help you review it and you'll have fun making a new stepping song. Can you think of a good name for your new song?
- Have fun with the new grown up notes, new lines and alphabet names for each key!
- Today there is a great new game for you in the Games Room. Help the bird gather leaves for his nest. With both hand in "Middle C" position play the note on your piano keyboard that matches the letter on the falling leaf! If you're not quick the gardener will rake up the leaves!
